





2018 "Science & Superheroes" Contest Official Rules & Guidelines

INSTRUCTIONS

Invent a new superhero character who uses superpowers with some origin or characteristic based on science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM) to deal with a real-world problem.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Only one entry per child is allowed, and submissions must not contain any trademarked or copyrighted material. Submissions must have <u>two</u> components and adhere to the following specifications:

1) An original drawing

- Drawing must fit on one standard sheet of *white un-lined* 8½" x 11" paper; any media is allowed; vertical or horizontal orientation. Printouts of digitally-created drawings are not permitted.
- Provide the superhero's name and any appropriate labels for the costume, gadgets, etc.
- On the back, in the lower right corner, print the contestant's <u>grade</u> only. (<u>IMPORTANT</u>:
 Do not include any other identifying information on the front or back of the drawing.)

2) A written description

- Description must fit on one <u>side</u> of a standard sheet of 8 ½" x 11" paper.
- Provide the superhero's name and a detailed explanation of the STEM principles utilized for his/her superpowers and/or origin.
- Explain how the superhero will utilize his/her superpowers to address a real-world problem.
- On the back, in the lower right corner, print the contestant's grade only. (<u>IMPORTANT</u>:
 Do not include any other identifying information on the front or back of the
 description.)

ENTRY FORM

Each submission must include a completed Entry Form in order to qualify. An official Entry Form can be downloaded at http://spandexcity.com/ScienceSuperheroes

Securely *clip* the Entry Form to the two drawing and description pages upon submission. <u>Do not staple</u> the pages together.

AWARDS CATEGORIES

- Grades K-2
- Grades 6-8
- Grades 3-5
- Grades 9-12

JUDGING

Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

- Artistic quality (20 points)
- Neatness, spelling, and grammar (5 points)
- Description of superhero origin (10 points)
- Description of superpowers (10 points)
- Application to a real-world problem (10 points)
- Originality of problem (5 points)
- Originality of character (10 points)
- Relevance of STEM to character's description (15 points)
- Quality of STEM research (15 points)

AWARDS CEREMONY

All contestants are invited to join us for the Science & Superheroes Contest Awards Ceremony on Sunday, April 29, 2018 at Discovery Place. Winners' entries will be presented. Stay tuned for more details.

CONTEST ELIGIBILITY

Open to all students in grades K-12 residing in Cabarrus, Gaston, Iredell, Lincoln, Mecklenburg, York and Union counties. Children of employees of Spandex City Comics, Discovery Place, and any other entities identified as partners or sponsors during the contest are not eligible to win, but may submit an entry for display.
